The President's Circle is an annual giving circle designed for individuals and small businesses seeking meaningful engagement with the T.D. Jakes Foundation and its leadership. With investment levels ranging from \$1,000 to \$10,000, the President's Circle offers an accessible entry point into the Foundation's impact ecosystem while providing members with connection, insight, and purpose-driven community.

Members of the President's Circle are convened virtually twice per year by the President for curated conversations on impact, strategy, and emerging priorities, and receive dedicated access and recognition at select flagship events, including the Martha's Vineyard Experience and the T7 Summit (where applicable). The President's Circle creates a space where values-aligned supporters can deepen their relationship with the Foundation and participate in shaping its future.

Outlook for 2026

Driving Growth, Partnership and Measurable Outcomes



Reach

Scale philanthropic investment to expand the Foundation's national footprint by nearly 40% year over year, with a goal of serving more than 1,000,000 individuals in 2026. Strategic funding enables technology-driven, partnership-powered delivery models that extend reach efficiently while sustaining momentum built on last year's 40x growth in impact.

Partnerships

Leverage philanthropic capital to deepen strategic partnerships that expand national access points and delivery channels. Targeted grant-making and collaborative investments allow partners to co-create solutions, extend shared outcomes, and amplify impact beyond what any single organization could achieve alone.

Platforms

Invest in the transition from stand-alone programs to integrated, evergreen platforms that operate year-round at national scale. Funding supports infrastructure such as vFairs and digital engagement tools that enable continuous participation, broader access, and consistent impact well beyond individual events.

Community-Centered Design

Direct investment toward community-informed program design, ensuring solutions are culturally responsive, locally grounded, and more likely to succeed long term. Philanthropic support strengthens place-based partnerships, such as those in Augusta and with the Dallas Regional Chamber, where local insight drives more effective outcomes.

Outcomes

Prioritize investments that measure success by long-term economic mobility and quality-of-life outcomes, not participation alone. Funding advances data collection, evaluation tools, and longitudinal tracking systems that allow investors to see how impact unfolds over time.

Future Readiness

Channel capital into sustainable systems that prepare individuals and families for the future economy, equipping them with future-ready skills, financial stability, and clear pathways to opportunity. These investments ensure communities are positioned not just to recover, but to thrive in a rapidly changing economic landscape.
